PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURGERY

1. Do not eat or drink anything after midnight, unless instructed by the doctor or the operating room nurse.
2. On the morning of your surgery you may brush your teeth, but do not swallow any fluid. If you have been so instructed, take any necessary medication with as little water as possible.
3. Report to the Day Surgery Admitting Office at the East Cooper Regional Medical Center at your appointed time; they will direct you to Day Surgery.
4. If you are taking any blood thinners (i.e., ASPIRIN, coumadin, etc.) please call the office 2 weeks prior to your scheduled surgery date.
