PRE-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS FOR SURGERY

1. Do not drink or eat anything 10 hours before surgery, unless instructed by the doctor or the operating room nurse.
2. On the morning of your surgery you may brush your teeth, but do not swallow any fluid. If you have been instructed, take any necessary medications with as little water as possible.
3. Report to East Cooper Regional Medical Center at your appointed time.
